Clusters' positive impact:

- Key factors in attracting capital, people and knowledge.
- Powerful tools in promoting research, development and innovation.
- Lower the barriers for transforming new ideas into businesses.
- Positive impacts on R&D investments innovation and R&D collaboration.

- VISION: To achieve a critical mass of innovative companies and organizations in the region.






